METRO WINDOW MANAGER



Organización de Iconos

- Mover con keyboard/Mouse

Click en icono, “Drag & Drop” en el grupo que desea


- “Touch Screen”

Presionar en icono, cuando aparece  “drag & drop” en grupo deseado

- Crear un nuevo grupo

Para ver los grupos, minimice en la parte inferior derecha o si es “touch”, extienda los dedos en la pantalla y luego haga “zoom out”

- Click o toque un icono en la pantalla
- Arrastre entre medio de dos grupos hasta ver una línea vertical
- Suelte el icono
- Minimice la pantalla
- Right click o tóquelo y deslice hasta ver 
- Click o toque “Name Group”, y asigne un nombre



NAVEGANDO EN LAS APLICACIONES

- Cerrar una aplicación con keyboard/mouse

Forma 1: Oprima ALT F4

Forma 2: Puede cerrarla haciendo click en la esquina superior izquierda, desde la pantalla **Start**, le aparece la aplicación, haga right click y escoja **close**

Forma 3: Mueva el cursor a la parte superior centro de la pantalla (dentro de la aplicación que quiere cerrar), cuando aparece una mano, haga click y arrastre hasta la parte inferior de la pantalla.

- Cerrar aplicación en pantalla “touch”

Arrastre la aplicación hasta la parte inferior de la pantalla
Forzar a cerrarla:

Desde el menú, escoja **Start**, Click en **Search**, aparecen todas las aplicaciones, escriba **Task Manager**, Click en **Task Manager**,

Remover y colocar iconos en el menú de Start


Remover
